The Costs of War

Bush lied about the reasons for war, no weapons of mass destruction have been found, and the Iraqi people are furiously fighting against the U.S. occupation of their country. Tens of thousands of Iraqis and over 1,000 U.S. soldiers have lost their lives, and more than 7,000 officially listed as wounded. Nevertheless, hundreds of thousands of occupying troops remain in Iraq, unwelcome, with no near end in sight.

The occupation costs \$237 million per day, \$1.6 billion per week. More than \$150 billion has been spent already on a war based on lies. These are precious resources, paid for by our tax-dollars, that our communities desperately need for jobs, health care, schools, and housing. Many of us watch our sons and daughters go off to war because the military is their only opportunity for a job or education. The war and occupation costs us all. Unless you own an oil company or a major corporation, you are not benefiting from the war.

A powerful global anti-war movement became a major political factor even before the war started. We know the power of people taking to the streets to demand peace and justice, and we believe this is the only force that can stop U.S. war and militarism.

Who can vote and where will the votes go?

Anyone can vote in the People's Anti-War Referendum. Unlike U.S. elections, our referendum doesn't discriminate by age, immigration status, or prison history. We are all effected by the U.S. policies of war and occupation, and we should have a say.

When you vote in the People's Anti-War Referendum, your name will not be sent to any branch of the government. Signatures will be collected and presented to the media just before the November election in a display of the strength of the opposition to the war. In addition, those who vote will be notified of the next national anti-war activity.
